Dear Teacher/Potential Teacher,

We are in the planning process for the 2014 IHDA Painting Retreat. The Retreat Committee would appreciate your commitment to share your skills, knowledge and techniques by teaching a class. We are looking for a variety of projects in different mediums for ALL skill levels from the "never picked up a brush" to the advanced painter, and for new craft techniques.

We offer a <u>free weekend</u> to teachers (50% off registration fee for teaching a make-it-take-it). Your weekend includes **lodging at the campground, meals, classes** and as much fun as you can handle. If you decide to stay in a motel in the area rather than at the camp, you are responsible for making and paying for those provisions.

The following is required when submitting your teaching projects:

- 1. Please observe the artist's design copyright rules before providing copies to students. You may need to get the artist's permission to teach or to print copies of the design. Some teachers may require that the student purchase their packet or book; if so, most artists usually offer a discounted price to students.
- 2. Complete the IHDA Teacher Project Form enclosed. List ALL paints in numerical order needed to complete the project. Paint (acrylic, watercolor, glass enamels or fabric) will be provided by the Allerton Retreat Committee. Any Other mediums (oils, etc.) will be provided by teachers for a reasonable palette fee to students. For pencil projects, you may either offer as a kit or provide a source for purchasing the pencils.
- 3. Please fill out and sign the enclosed teacher time preference card.
- 4. Provide a photo of your project. This must be a photo of your own project and <u>not</u> the original artist's picture. Photos must be printed on <u>glossy</u> photo paper for clarity in the catalog. OR photos may be emailed to the Chairman as a digital photo.

 ABSOLUTELY NO PHOTOS WILL BE ACCEPTED ON REGULAR COPY PAPER!
- 5. Include a clear copy of your pattern, the surface size and if the student is allowed to re-size the project to fit their surface.
- 6. Provide <u>clearly-typed prep instructions</u>, including the palette list of all paints used and supplies needed.
- 7. Please make it clear (in your project instructions and on the Teacher Project Form) where the student can purchase the surface and any special supplies needed for the class.
- 8. KITS: If you offer a "Kit Project," please clearly list what is included in the kit, the cost, and if prepayment is required at the time of registering.
- 9. Please place ALL required information listed above (prep instructions, Teacher Project Form, signed teacher time preference card, pattern and photo) in a sheet protector when submitting to Committee.

DEADLINE for teachers to receive free weekend is <u>OCTOBER 19, 2013</u>. If you submit late (October 19 – November 2), you will receive a 50% discount. Make-it-take-its are considered a half class and will receive a 25% discount if submitted late.

NO EXCEPTIONS TO THE RULES WILL BE GRANTED!
